Ismail worked closely with a larger Architecture team on the design of this massive project which includes a 156,000+ Square-foot Warehouse and a Fuel Facility. This facility was opened to the public on Thanksgiving of 2023. The store is expected to hire about 200 employees, while generating about \$2 million in annual sales tax revenue and \$200,000 in property taxes, city officials said.
